

Anti-bribery and Corruption Policy for October 6 University

Purpose:

October 6 University is committed to conducting business in an ethical and transparent manner. We do not tolerate any form of bribery or corruption and are committed to preventing such practices within the university and any organizations with which we do business.

Policy Statement:

At October 6 University, we prohibit any form of bribery or corruption, whether direct or indirect, and regardless of the size or value of the transaction. We are committed to complying with all applicable laws and regulations related to bribery and corruption, including the United Nations Convention against Corruption and the Egyptian Penal Code.

We expect all members of the university community, including employees, students, and third-party contractors, to act with integrity and uphold the values of the university. We will not tolerate any behaviour that violates this policy, and we will take appropriate action against any individual or organization that engages in bribery or corruption.

Implementation:

To achieve this policy, October 6 University will:

1. Provide training and support to all members of the university community to raise awareness and understanding of bribery and corruption, including how to identify and report any suspected cases.
2. Develop and implement policies and procedures that promote transparency and accountability in all financial transactions, including due diligence checks on third-party contractors and suppliers.
3. Ensure that all financial transactions are accurately and transparently recorded and reported, and that appropriate internal controls and oversight mechanisms are in place to prevent and detect any instances of bribery or corruption.
4. Encourage and support the reporting of any suspected cases of bribery or corruption and ensure that a clear and confidential reporting mechanism is in place.
5. Take appropriate disciplinary and legal action against any individual or organization found to have engaged in bribery or corruption, including termination of employment, contract cancellation, and referral to law enforcement authorities.
