

Waste Disposal Policy with Emphasis on Hazardous Materials

Policy Statement: October 6 University is committed to maintaining a safe and environmentally responsible campus. The university strictly adheres to waste disposal practices that prioritize safety, compliance, and sustainability, with a special emphasis on the proper management of hazardous materials.

Policy Details:

1. Scope:

- This policy applies to all university-owned and operated facilities and campuses, including laboratories, maintenance areas, and any other locations where hazardous materials may be used, generated, or stored.

2. Hazardous Materials Identification:

- The university encourages waste minimization practices to reduce the generation of hazardous waste, promoting the use of alternative materials and the implementation of waste reduction techniques.

6. Transportation and Disposal:

- October 6 University will ensure that hazardous waste is transported and disposed of by licensed and authorized waste management services, complying with all relevant regulations and standards.

7. Emergency Response:

- The university will establish emergency response procedures in case of hazardous material spills or accidents, including notification, containment, and reporting protocols.

8. Compliance:

- October 6 University will ensure that all waste disposal practices are in compliance with applicable federal, state, and local laws and regulations, including those related to hazardous waste management.
