**Subject: In the context of community service and environmental development, and out of 6th of October University's keenness to participate in Egypt's celebration of the International Literacy Day, especially since it is the first private university that worked to eradicate illiteracy among its employees and obtained the certificate of the first private university free of illiteracy, and this was mentioned in the celebration. Prof. Dr. Fatima Barakat, Vice Dean of the Faculty of Education for Community Service and Environmental Development Affairs, attended this celebration based on an invitation addressed to her and with the support of Her Excellency Dean/ Ruqayya Shalaby, Dean of the Faculty. Also attending from the students were student Malak Sayed Mohamed in the third year of the Special Education Department, student Abdul Rahman Ali Ibrahim in the fourth year of the Arabic Language Department, and student Youssef Magdy Mohamed in the third year of the Psychology Department. This attendance comes in response to the decision of the General Conference of the United Nations Educational, Scientific and Cultural Organization, which determined that September 8 of each year be the International Literacy Day. Therefore, the General Authority for Adult Education, headed by Professor Dr. Eid Abdel Wahid - Chairman of the Executive Authority of the Authority, organizes this celebration in the presence of a group of: Ministers, governors, university presidents,**

**state institutions and society Civil, regional and international, and parties headed by Her Excellency Ambassador Moushira Khattab, President of the National Council for Human Rights.**

**This celebration comes in response to the call of His Excellency President Abdel Fattah El-Sisi - President of the Republic to knock on all available doors: in order to eliminate illiteracy in our beloved country Egypt.**

**And that the new vision of the Authority must keep pace with the renewal of the concepts of literacy and adult education, as our uneducated people have a lot of experience and culture, so we must rethink adult education in Egypt, and the role of partners has become important in contributing effectively to this issue as the transition to continuous learning and education for adults.**

**The new vision of the Authority is based on the transition from alphabetical illiteracy to entrepreneurship, digital coexistence, quality of life, and innovation, while paying attention to people with disabilities to integrate them into society. There must be a scientific methodology for studying the evaluation of the content of illiteracy tests so that it includes the cultural and skill aspects, entrepreneurship, and digital coexistence in addition to the alphabet. Preparations are now underway to introduce a multi-digital curriculum for people with intellectual disabilities who are capable of learning, with awareness and educational seminars being held to raise awareness of various topics such as: the danger of population growth, preserving the environment, and greening, confronting electronic rumors, and consolidating the values of loyalty and citizenship. ... etc. The Authority's work during this period is based on building on the achievements of the modern state, as we must develop our behaviors to preserve these gains. Through a new life based on awareness education in the most needy places, especially in villages, hamlets and hamlets: The state's goals must be achieved and the services provided in housing, health and infrastructure must be made a tangible reality. We must go down to the ground and coordinate with various parties to**

**provide new and innovative packages to educate and educate the uneducated among our people to preserve these gains for all of us: adults and children, educated and uneducated. This is done through integration and communication between the Authority and partner parties to spread education and awareness of various community issues. To create this state of integration, we must have aware, influential and positive individuals who have an important role in influencing society and individuals. This celebration coincides with the announcement of Egypt winning the UNESCO Literacy Prize this year, represented by Mansoura University in partnership with the Adult Education Authority, which came as a sincere expression and international recognition of what Egypt has done and is doing, its leadership and institutions, for the quality of life of the Egyptian citizen, which stems from education. The Adult Education Authority also announces that seven governorates have reached the virtual zero and officially declared them governorates free of illiteracy. Some of the shining examples who were liberated from illiteracy and continued their education until they obtained the highest academic degrees were honored, and people with disabilities who obtained a literacy certificate were also honored. The celebration also included presenting the effective steps that were accomplished by the Adult Education Authority in partnership with some state institutions, and some civil society, regional and international organizations, renewing through them a positive appeal to all parties to participate effectively in addressing the issue of illiteracy as one of the strategic priorities: to achieve democracy and sustainable development for our great Egyptian people who deserve to obtain their right to education, and this can only be achieved by eliminating illiteracy. 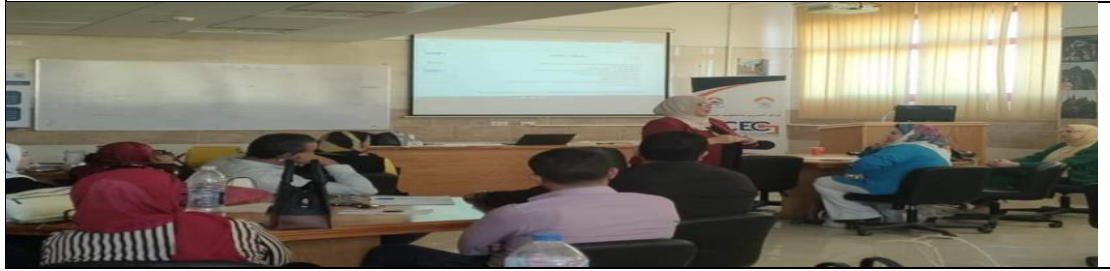

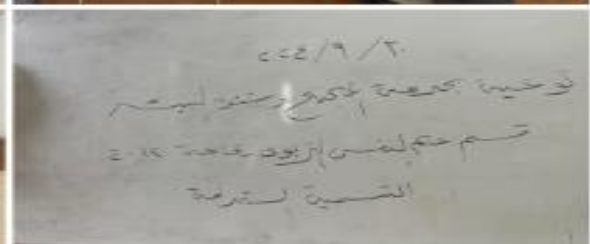

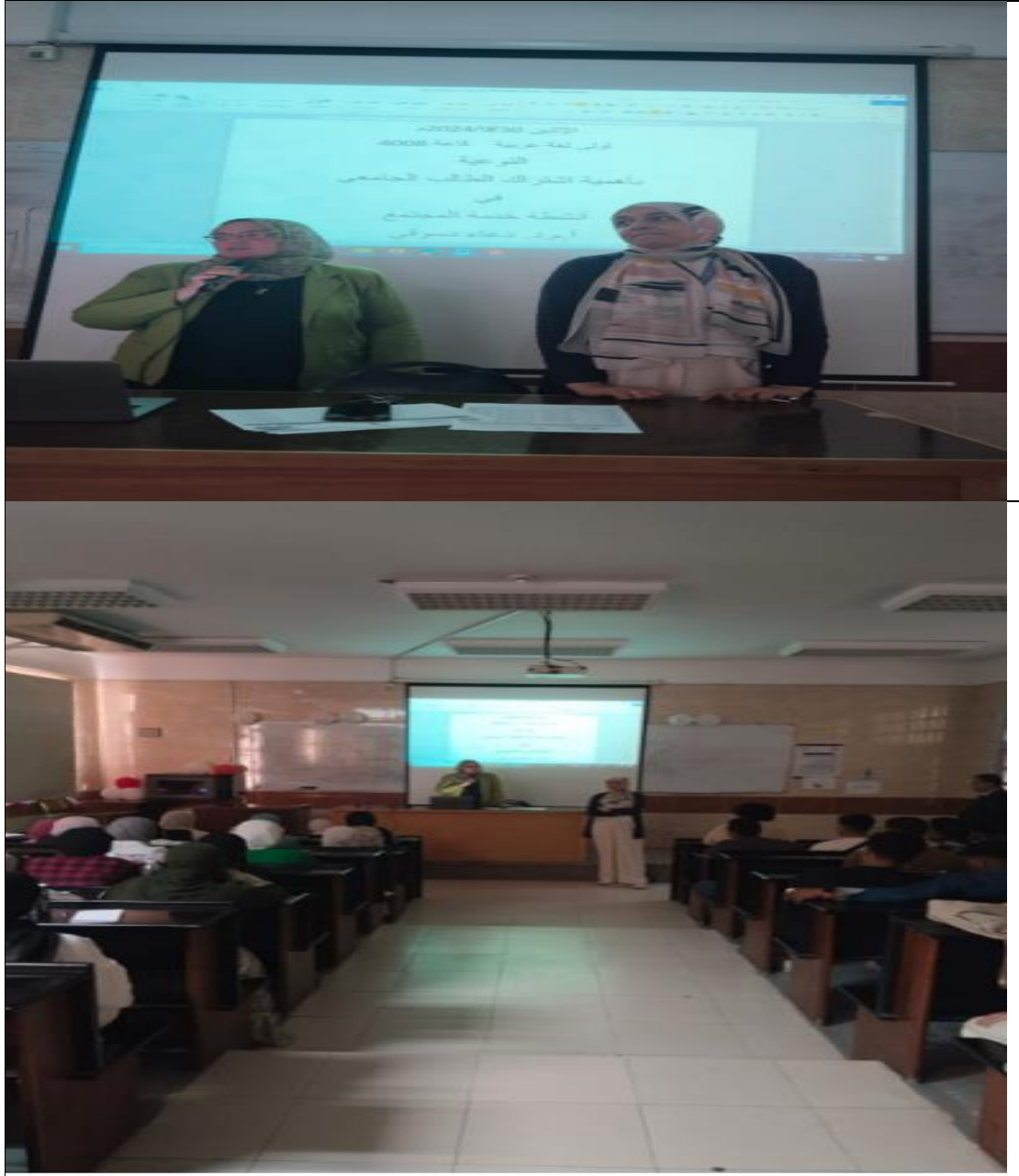
