The objective of the activity is to achieve the fourth goal of sustainable development, which is quality education. Studies continued in the literacy classes in the Asmarat neighborhood after Eid al-Fitr. Studies continued today in the fifth literacy class of the Cairo branch in the Asmarat neighborhood. This is in implementation of the cooperation protocol between the National Council for Women and the General Authority for Literacy and Adult Education. This aims to empower women socially, economically, and politically. Implemented and coordinated by Prof. Dr. Rukia Shalaby, Dean of the Faculty of Education and Alternate Rapporteur of the National Council for Women, Cairo Branch. This was attended by Ms. Naglaa Mahmoud, Director of the Khalifa and Mokattam Department for Literacy and Adult Education. The study began at 10:00 a.m., confirming the regularity of study as the exam date is approaching at the end of this month. This was done in the presence of the class facilitator who started the day by conducting a simple test as usual to determine whether each student has mastered writing their name easily. She continued to ensure that they have memorized and familiarized them with the alphabet, writing and reading, diacritics, correct pronunciation and letter articulation so that they can write correctly and read properly. The class facilitator was keen to have the students go out and write on the board with their hands to remove their fear of writing and making mistakes. Numbers and how to write them were explained, as well as some simple arithmetic problems such as addition, subtraction, multiplication and division. The necessity of commitment and presence at the agreed-upon times was clarified, as the students' attendance and absence will be monitored to determine the extent of their commitment, diligence and interest in studying. They were encouraged and guided regarding some of the rules that must be adhered to in the exam.

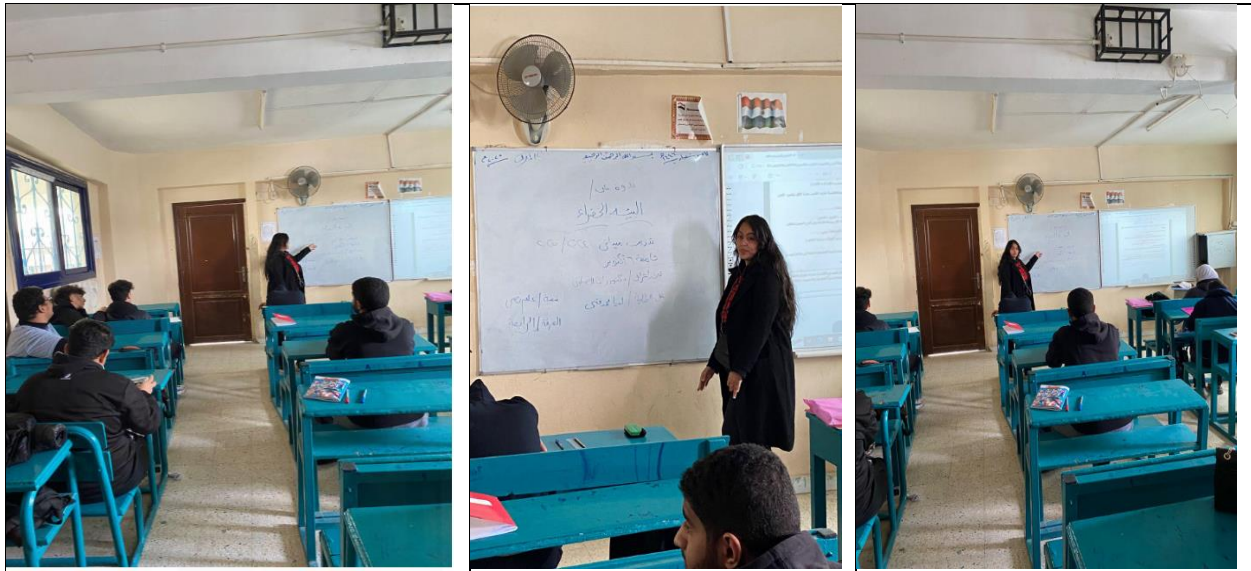

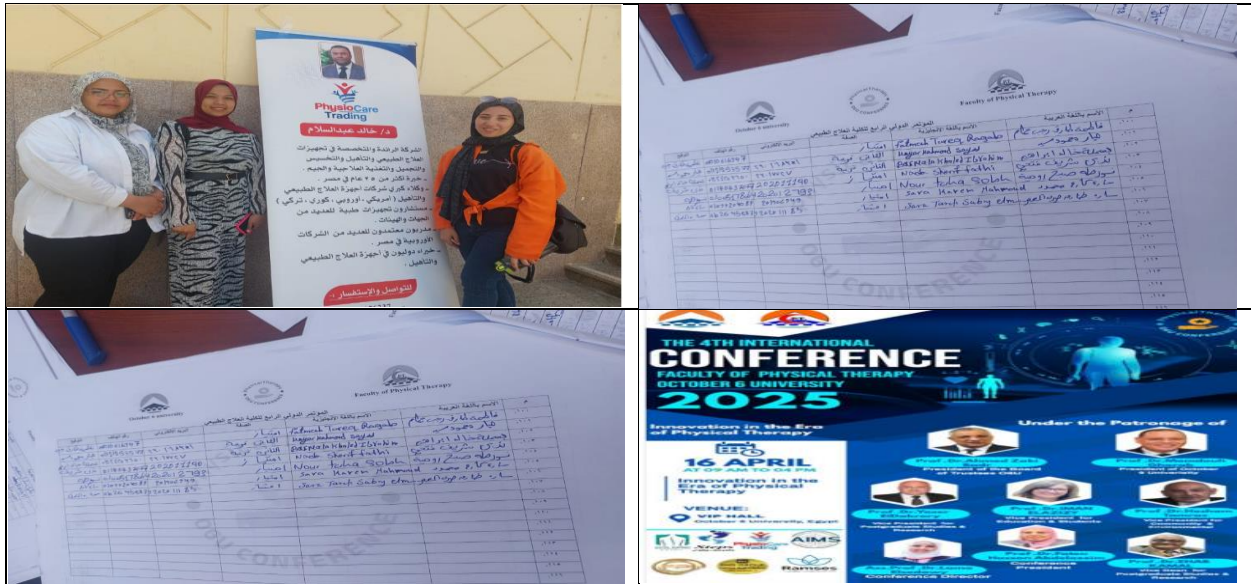

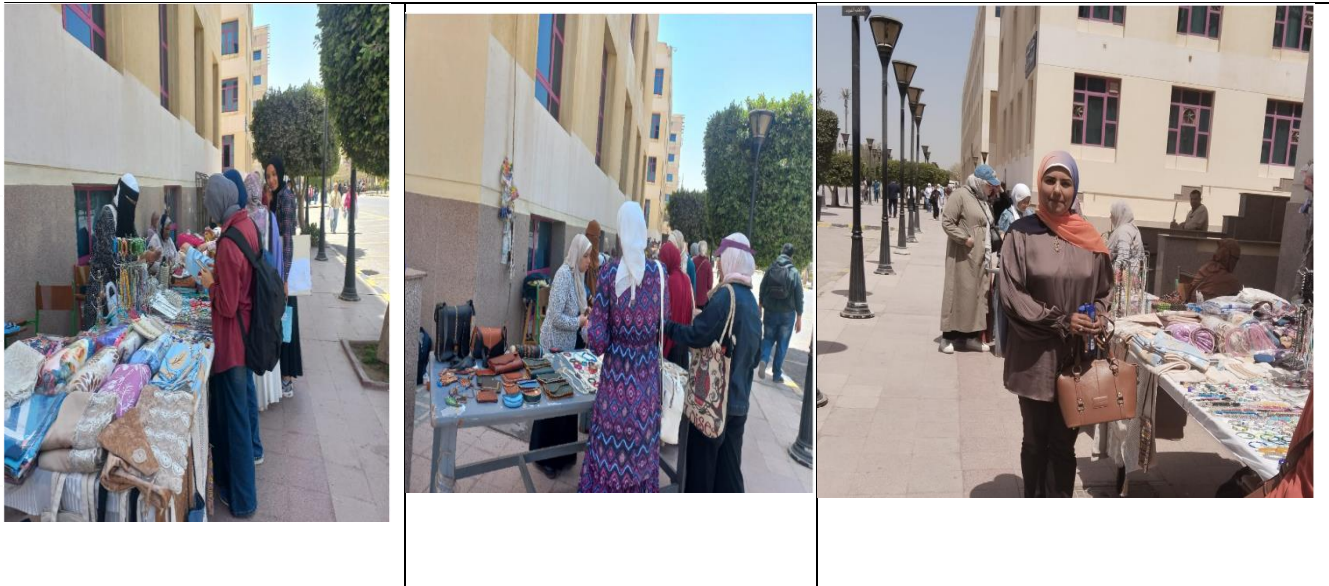
