Activity Date: Thursday, February 13, 2025

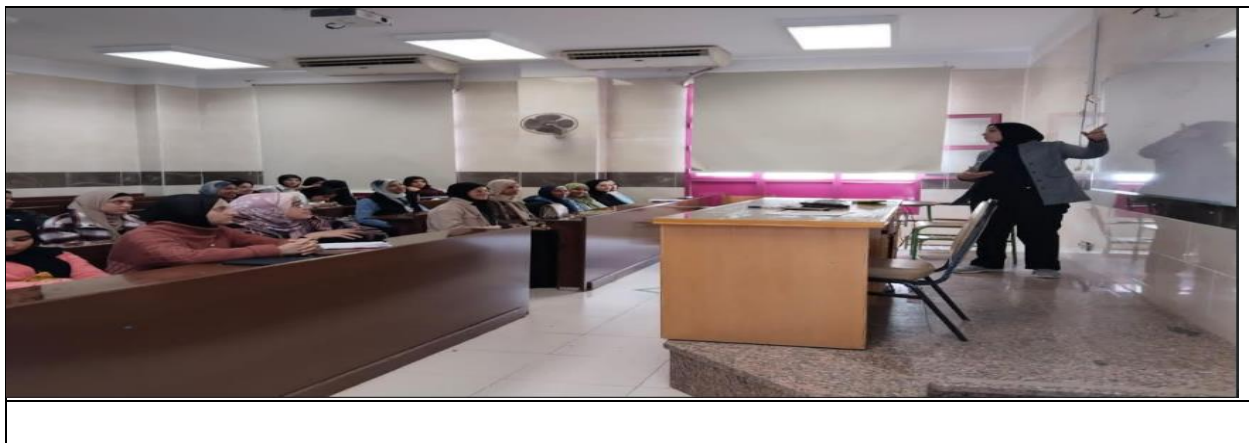

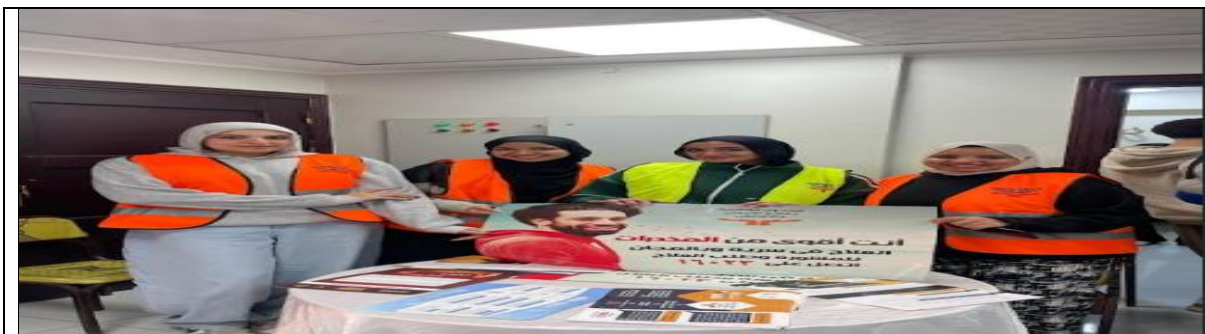

Subject: Prof. Dr. Ruqayya Shalaby, Dean of the Faculty of Education, followed up on the continuation of studies in the fifth literacy class in the Asmarat neighborhood, in order to empower women socially, economically and politically.

The study began at ten in the morning, where the necessary books for study, study tools, notebooks and pens were distributed to the new students. This was in the presence of the class facilitator (class teacher), who began by introducing them to the alphabet, writing and reading, diacritics, how to pronounce it correctly and the exits of the letters so that they could write correctly and read correctly. The class facilitator was keen for the students to go out and write on the board with their hands to remove the fear of writing and making mistakes from them. The necessity of commitment and presence at the agreed upon specific times was explained, as the attendance and absence of the students will be monitored to know the extent of their commitment, keenness and interest in studying. They were encouraged and guided by some controls that will be implemented. It was agreed that next Monday, corresponding to 2/24, will be the regular day of study on Mondays and Thursdays of every week until the beginning of March, the holy month of Ramadan. The times will be changed from ten in the morning until twelve noon.

Subject: Within the framework of community service and environmental development, and the keenness of the Faculty of Education to educate students about the latest services provided to people with special needs, this visit was coordinated in the presence of Prof. Dr. Ruqayya Shalaby, Dean of the Faculty of Education, Prof. Dr. Fatima Barakat, Vice Dean of the Faculty of Education for Community Service and Environmental Development Affairs (Coordination and Organization) - Assistant Professor Dr. Doaa Desouky, Acting Head of the Education Department, Ms. Aya Magdy, Assistant Lecturer in the Kindergarten Department - Ms. Maryam Muhammad Muhammad, Teaching Assistant in the Education Department, and a number of (24) male and female students from the Faculty Education in the departments of special education and psychology - and attended from the Faculty of Medicine Dr. Donia Hani and 2 students from the Faculty of Medicine (a list of names is attached). The delegation of October 6 University arrived at exactly 10:30 am and the visit continued until 1:30 pm where the university delegation was received by the Dean, Doctor / Wael Al-Saidi, Director of the Center

The visit began with presentations for children with disabilities and various - artistic segments

Then a presentation to introduce the center and the services it provides -

Then the start to see and get to know the departments and clinics of the - center where all units were visited

And to get to know the nature of the work of each of them as follows: -

Learning Difficulties Unit: It contains a group of programs including the - development of visual skills and the focus and attention program and the visual skills group - first, second, third and fourth introductory level and a group of animal colors and colors and animal cards and vegetable cards and fruit cards and bird cards

Occupational Therapy Unit: In it, some problems resulting from a disorder - or deficiency in one of the senses or muscles or in the nervous system are treated, which led to problems in the functional performance of the child's muscles Such as the child's hand tremor when closing the buttons of his shirt, or the child's inability to tie his shoelaces, and other problems that also affect the child's ability to hold a pen and learn to write. - **Behavior modification unit:** In it, the specialist uses the unit's tools to treat the child from some unwanted behaviors such as extreme emotional behavior, biting behavior, aggressive behavior, and hair-pulling behavior. It also refines the behavior of children suffering from attention deficit hyperactivity disorder and autism children.

Skills development unit: It has tools to develop all the skills that the child - may suffer from deficiency in, such as developing the counting skill, developing the spelling skill, developing the visual coordination skill, the visual-motor coordination skill, and other different skills.

Montessori unit: It has all the tools that work on the Montessori principle in - treatment, such as tools for learning arithmetic through UCMAS, rough sanded number cards, printed number cards, and the meaning of each number of shapes and objects. There are also tools for learning to read by providing the child with the words he needs in his environment, such as a group of vegetables and fruits, a group of means of transportation, and tableware.

Ozone and water therapy: It has devices to provide children who need the - ozone element to complete their treatment, as well as swimming pools Miniature enough for the child and the trainer, equipped with two underwater chairs and pumps to calm the child and start water therapy sessions.

Speech unit: It contains illustrated speech books, a smart speech group, a series of stories, a group of singular, dual and plural, and a group of masculine and feminine

Sensory integration unit: It has laser devices and specific lighting to calm the child to conduct sensory integration sessions, which are important sessions for children who suffer from sensory disorders such as autistic children not feeling their right or left side, and such as hypersensitivity in hearing, sight, touch or taste

Dental clinic for people with special needs: It is a dental clinic for children - equipped with special devices for autistic children. The diplomas offered by the center and accredited by Ain Shams University and the center were also introduced, such as: • Speech diploma - • Occupational therapy diploma - • Special education diploma - • Sensory integration diploma - • Montessori diploma
