This symposium, as part of ongoing efforts to promote moral and religious values in society, will feature the participation of a select group of academics, researchers, and those interested in educational and religious affairs from various Egyptian universities. Second: Symposium Objectives: To highlight the moral values embodied in the holy month of Ramadan. To highlight the impact of these values on individual upbringing, family cohesion, and societal stability. To promote religious and behavioral concepts in the educational context. To create opportunities for dialogue among specialists on the role of Ramadan values in reforming societies. Third: Symposium Participants: 98 participants from diverse academic backgrounds participated in the symposium. Their grades and positions were distributed as follows: 2 professors – 4 associate professors – 6 assistant professors – 11 lecturers – 2 assistant lecturers – 2 teaching assistants – 49 students – 6 graduates – 10 academic researchers – 4 teachers – 2 from other categories (engineers) In terms of geographical distribution: The majority are from the Arab Republic of Egypt. The participants belong to different universities such as: 6th of October University, Cairo University, Ain Shams University, and others. In terms of gender distribution: 72 females – 26 males. Fourth: Seminar Evaluation The participants' opinions about the level of the seminar were collected, and the results were as follows: 87 participants rated the seminar as "Excellent". 9 participants rated it as "Very Good". They only gave a "Good" rating. This evaluation reflects a high level of satisfaction with the seminar's content and organization, indicating its effectiveness in achieving its objectives.
