Objective of the Activity:

To achieve all Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs).

Topic:

As part of the community service and environmental development efforts, and in line with the University of 6th October's commitment to representing its members at international forums, Prof. Dr. Rokaya Shalaby, Dean of the Faculty of Education, and Prof. Dr. Fatima Barakat, Vice Dean for Community Service and Environmental Development, attended the World Urban Forum held in Cairo.

The 12th edition of the World Urban Forum (WUF) kicked off on Monday, November 4, 2024, under the auspices of Egyptian President Abdel Fattah El-Sisi. The forum is being attended by 30,000 participants from 180 countries, including 52 countries and 115 exhibitors from international and local organizations. The event also features heads of state, international officials, and around 103 ministers, 36 deputy ministers, and 300 governors, as well as approximately 900 volunteers helping to organize the event.

The forum is being held under the theme "Everything Starts Locally - Let's Work Together for Sustainable Cities and Communities" at the International Conference Center (Movenpick Cairo). The opening ceremony included the raising of the flags of Egypt and the United Nations, officially marking the start of the first day of the event, which runs from November 4–8, 2024. The World Urban Forum is a major UN conference on sustainable urban development, established in 2001 to address global urbanization challenges, one of the most pressing issues the world faces today. The forum is held biennially.

The celebration of raising the flags was attended by Dr. Manal Awad, Minister of Local Development; Ms. Claudia Rosbah, UN Under-Secretary-General and Executive Director of the UN Human Settlements Programme (UN-Habitat); and a number of Egyptian government officials and UN-Habitat representatives.

This year's forum in Cairo is significant as the city, with its rich heritage and modern development, marks a crucial point for sustainable urban development, especially as the forum returns to Africa after a 20-year hiatus. It brings together national, regional, and local government representatives, academics, business leaders, city planners, and civil society to discuss urgent urban challenges, including the housing crisis and climate change.

The forum includes 600 events focused on localizing the Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs) and tackling critical urban issues such as affordable housing and climate

change. It also hosts high-level dialogues aimed at accelerating the implementation of the new urban agenda and the 2030 Agenda for Sustainable Development. Additionally, the 2024 Global Cities Report on cities and climate change will be launched during the forum.

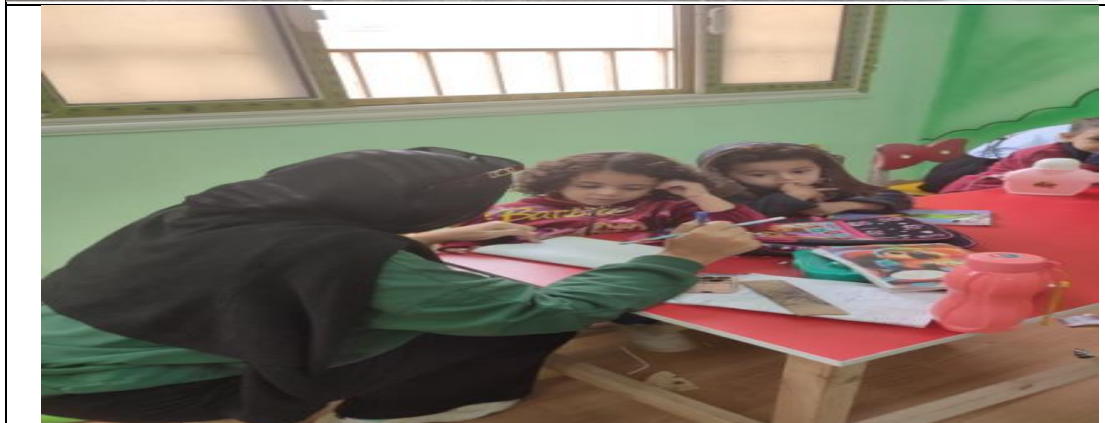

Objective of the Activity:

To achieve the Third Sustainable Development Goal (SDG 3), which is Good Health and Well-being.

Topic:

As part of the national plan to combat addiction and drug abuse, the Addiction Treatment and Prevention Fund, in collaboration with various universities and government ministries, organized this training camp in Abu Qir, Alexandria. The camp aimed to build a cadre of trained youth leaders who will participate in the national initiative to combat addiction and promote awareness in their communities.

This initiative is part of the Presidential Initiative "A New Beginning for Building the Human" and aims to equip 1,000 young trainees from youth centers across Egypt with the knowledge and skills necessary to address the challenges of addiction and drug abuse prevention.

The following faculty members from the Faculty of Education participated in the camp as supervisors and co-trainers:

Key Highlights of the Camp:

- The camp opened with a lecture on "**Types of Modern Drugs and Their Effects**" by Dr. Mohamed Mostafa, a toxicology and drug expert at the Forensic Medicine Authority. The lecture addressed the causes of drug abuse and addiction and discussed misconceptions surrounding drug use.
- A second lecture was given by Mr. Ahmed Abdel-Ghani, Director of the Statistics Department at the Addiction Treatment and Prevention Fund. He explained the dangers of drug abuse, how drugs are marketed, and how to recognize signs of abuse. He also spoke about Egypt's national strategy to increase awareness of the dangers of drugs and mental health issues and the efforts made to prevent and combat addiction.

- The camp included several **workshops** focused on enhancing youth knowledge about life skills and discussing addiction and drug abuse issues. It also provided training on **preventive interventions** and introduced innovative treatment strategies aimed at fostering positive changes and raising awareness about the importance of mental health.

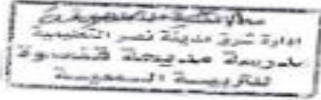

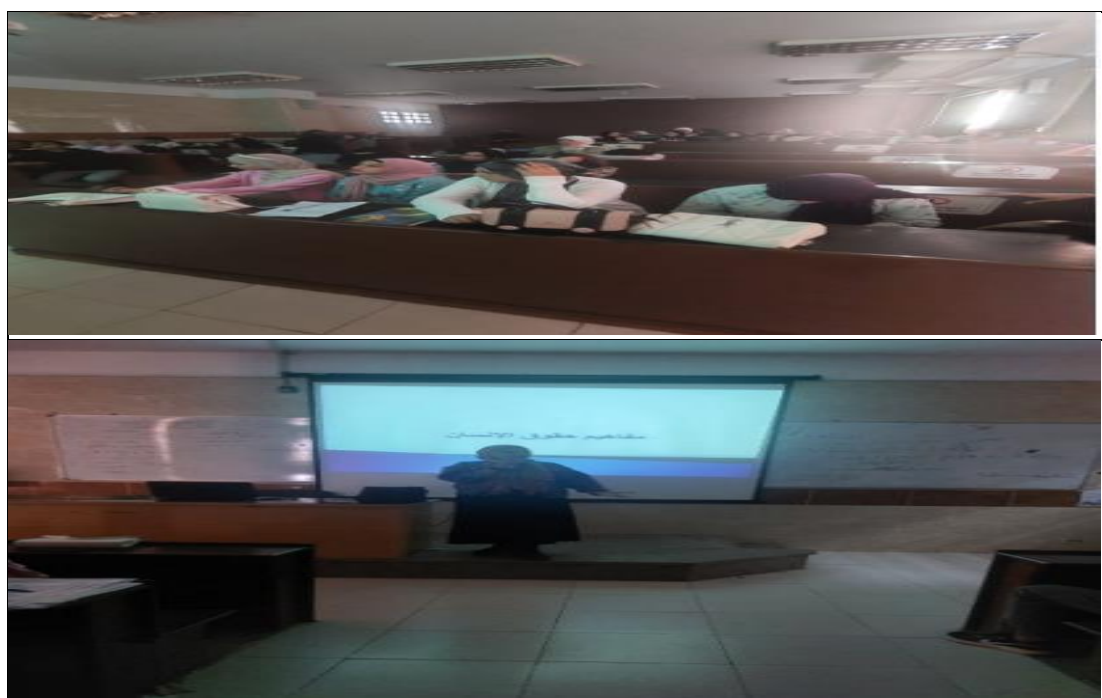
