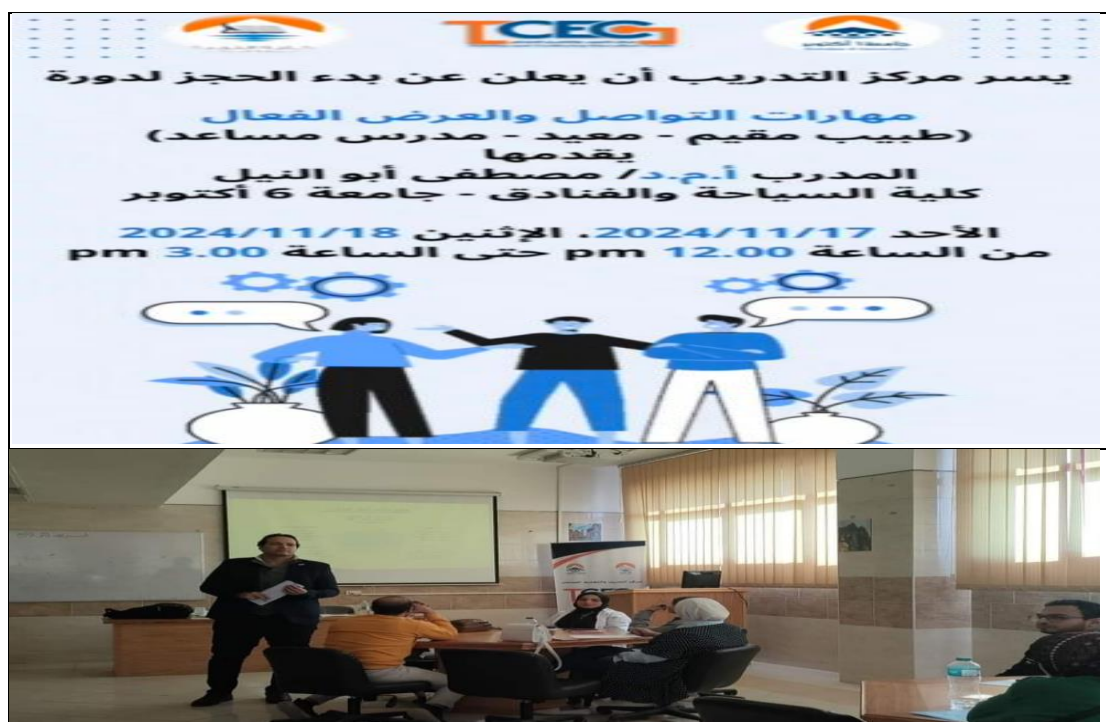

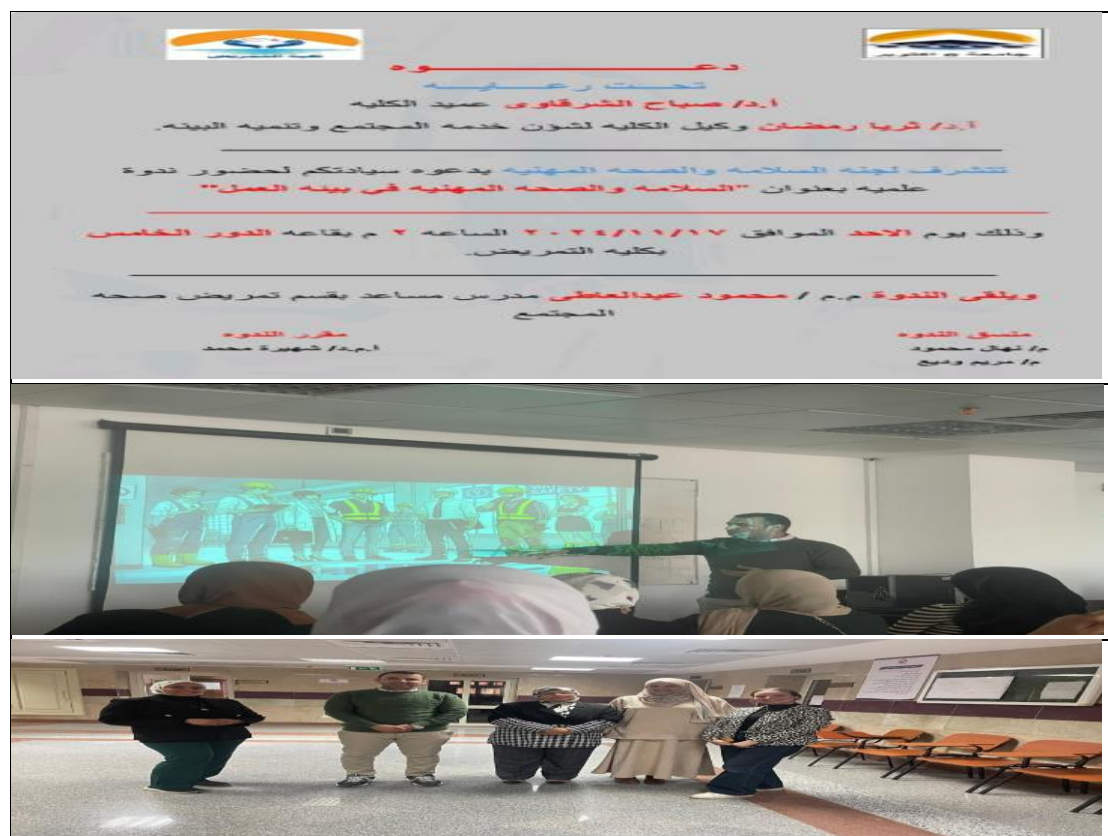

Prof. Dr. Nevin Makram spoke about what is cyber violence?

It is an act of violence committed or incited using information and communications technology, including mobile phones, the Internet, social media and email.

Women and girls who are exposed to cyber violence can feel fear, panic, anxiety and depression, which negatively affects their relationships, studies, work and social life.

There are five forms of cyber violence against women and girls:

Non-consensual sharing of images: the use and sharing of images, -1 whether manipulated or real, without the consent of the owner for the purpose of blackmail.

Online impersonation: creating a fake profile and impersonating -2 someone for harmful purposes, including damaging reputation or threatening safety

The role of the National Center for Housing and Building Research in supporting innovators, researchers and entrepreneurs.

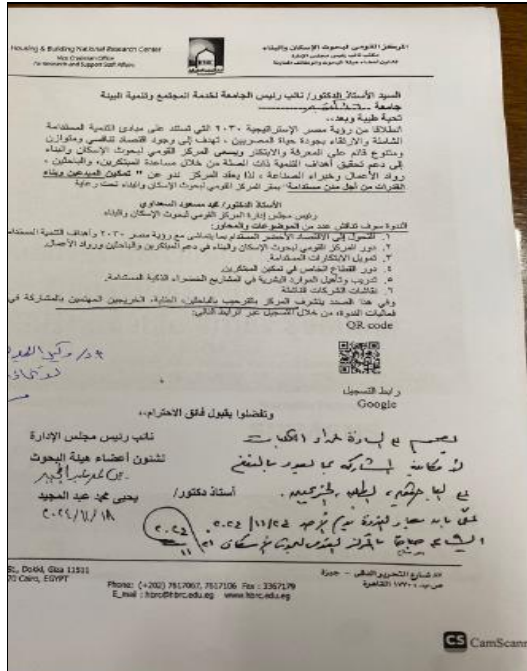
