-Name of the course: Anatomy

-Academic year: Second year – Second Semester

-Course title and Code: Anatomy VII (Anat 203) & Anatomy VIII (Anat 204)

-Contact hours (Credit hours): 4 hrs lectures & 4 hrs practical/ wk (6 cr)

-Course aims:

Anatomy VII provides an in-depth study of the gross anatomy of the **head and neck**. Anatomy VIII provides a detailed study of the gross anatomy of the **nervous system**. Emphasis is given to points of clinical relevance. Problem solving and interactive e-learning are integral parts of the course.

-ILOS:

Course ILOS

a1. **Describe** anatomical structure of any muscle, vessel, nerve, joint, organ or region of the head and neck.

a2. **Discuss** the anatomical structure, connections, blood supply and effect of lesion of any structure in the central nervous system.

b1. **Employ** anatomical knowledge to **solve clinical problems**, for example correlating between a given trauma (wound, fracture, ...etc.) or surgical procedure and the structure(s) liable to injury.

b2. **Interpret** diagnostic images and understand the clinically relevant condition.

c1. **Identify** a marked structure of the head and neck in a dissected cadaver, isolated brain, normal X-ray, MRI or computer image.

c2. **Identify** the features of the skull, cervical vertebrae and first rib; and the structure attached or related to a marked area of the bone or passing through a marked foramen.

d1. **Respect** disciplines, staff and colleagues regardless of social, cultural or ethnic backgrounds.

d2. **Run group research:** collect data via library \internet search, and present concise review about a chosen topic.
