

Integration of Environmental Sustainability Across Undergraduate and Postgraduate Curricula

Undergrad student courses

Environmental Management and Sustainable Tourism

1. **Human Being and Environment (UM211)**
Introduces environmental systems, human–environment interactions, environmental challenges, and sustainability principles.
2. **Environmental Management for Hotel Facilities (HE311)**
Examines the relationship between hospitality operations and environmental impacts, and teaches sustainable environmental management practices.
3. **Eco-Tourism and Sustainable Tourism (TM427)**
Focuses on sustainable tourism development, tourism planning, and environmental, economic, and social impacts of tourism activities.
4. **Managing Tourism Sites (TM216)**
Introduces tourism planning and sustainable management of tourism destinations.

Environment and Public Health

5. **Community Medicine (COMI 401–404)**
Includes environmental health risks, waste management, and public health issues related to environmental conditions.
6. **Water Safety (MNWF111)**
Addresses environmental health risks associated with water contamination and sustainable water management.

Sustainability Awareness and Education

7. **German as a Second Language – Sustainability Topics (08834207)**
Develops students' awareness of sustainability issues through language learning.
8. **Chinese as a Second Language – Sustainability Topics (CHC201, CHC215, CHC313, CHC413)**

Includes sustainability-related topics to build awareness and vocabulary related to environmental and sustainability issues.
