Accessibility and Inclusion Facilities

October 6 University (O6U) is dedicated to providing an inclusive, accessible, and supportive environment for all members of its community, including individuals with disabilities, nursing mothers, and families. The campus is thoughtfully designed and equipped to ensure comfort, safety, mobility, and equal opportunities for every individual.

Physical Accessibility Infrastructure

Key accessibility facilities include:

- 1. Ramps at the entrance of every building, ensuring barrier-free access.**
- 2. Accessible restrooms fitted with assistive devices.**
- 3. Pedestrian sidewalks facilitating safe movement between buildings.**
- 4. Elevators in all academic and administrative buildings.**
- 5. Interconnecting bridges enabling convenient mobility across campus.**
- 6. Designated parking spaces in underground areas for persons with disabilities.**
- 7. Accessible seating areas and specialized chairs for individuals with mobility needs.**
- 8. Electric golf cars (zero-emission vehicles) for transportation of students with mobility impairments.**

Health and Safety Services

- Emergency medical support, including a fully equipped on-campus ambulance service.**
- A University Hospital equipped with modern medical facilities and qualified healthcare professionals.**
- Availability of rehabilitation and physiotherapy services.**
- Continuous training for medical staff on disability-inclusive healthcare practices.**

Academic and Digital Accessibility

- Extended examination time and alternative assessment arrangements when required.**
